Practical Horticulture is a 'hands on' practical course for any students who enjoys been outside in the fresh air and getting their hands dirty. You will learn a range of new skills, which will help you on your career path to working in Horticulture.



The RHS Level 1 Introductory Award in Practical Horticulture focuses on developing the essential basic horticultural skills and inspire all those with an interest in gardening. Areas covered in the subject are preparation of soil for planting/growing, propagation of seeds/plants, planting and maintenance of flower/vegetable beds. This qualification leads onto a Level 1 qualification with 2 additional units to complete.

Assessment

Practical skills are assessed on an ongoing basis and we are here to help you every step of the way. You will not be put in for an assessment until you are ready. The course also has some theory tests. These tests give you a chance to show us how much you have learnt.

What next?

This course could lead to a progression pathway to employment, but also provide the foundation for further skills development at RHS levels 2 and 3.
