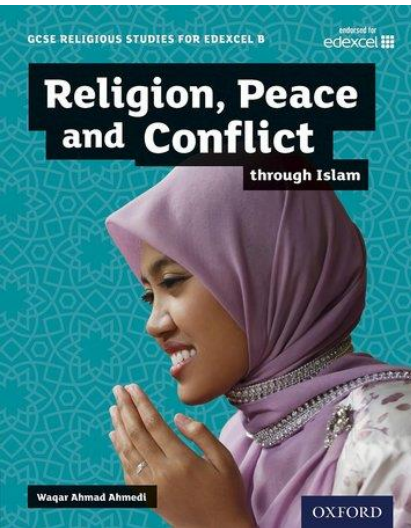

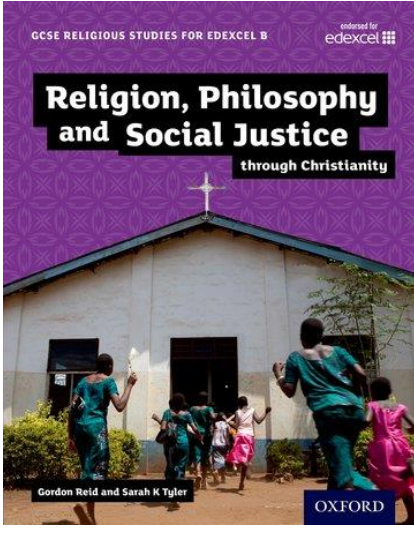

What to expect at GCSE...

Within GCSE Religious Studies we study the beliefs and actions of Islam and Christianity, comparing and critically analysing these beliefs against divergent beliefs and non-religious views.

We use the theology units to build knowledge in the faiths and then apply this knowledge to relevant themes.

GCSE Religious Studies is a unique opportunity to relay learning to current affairs, and we are often comparing the learning we have done in the classroom to the news in the wider world.
