1. How do the lessons differ from your lessons back in Spain?

We in Spain, we are the ones who change classes and not the teachers.

2. How does the school day differ?

We have 3 classes, a break and then we have the last three classes. For some who live far away or who can't go home after school to eat, they have to pay to eat at the institute.

3. How is the food here in school different?

We do not have a canteen, but we have a dining room that people stay after classes if they have any extra classes after finishing your schedule or if you live far away, because we finish classes at 2:30 p.m.

4. What has surprised you the most about school in England?

That they have the exams all together in a room because we do them each in their class. It has also caught our attention that in PE are divided into boys from girls

5. What could England learn from schools in Spain?

The only thing that Spanish schools are better than here is, that in Spain the school give you a personal Chromebook to work on.
