### Why support us? From small acorns, mighty oaks grow...

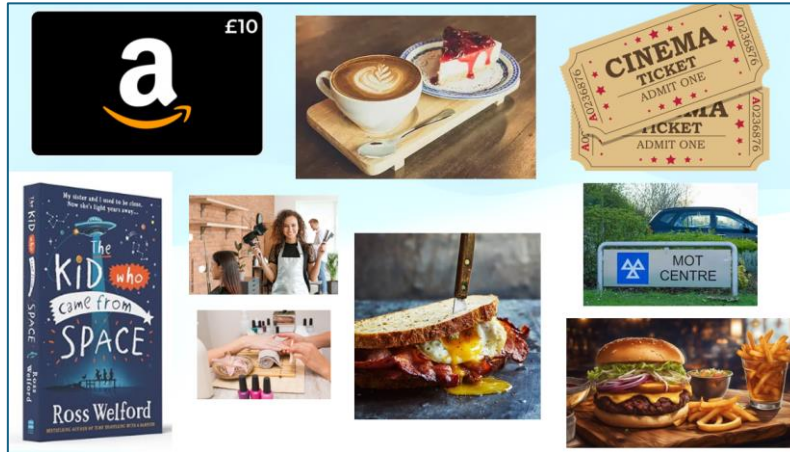
