Dear Parents/Carers,

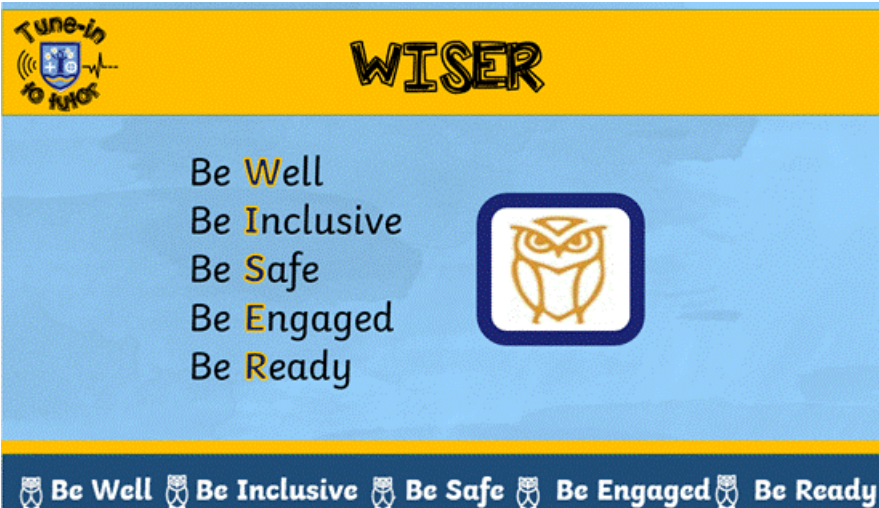

This week's updates include:

Anti-Bullying Information: As part of our WISER programme, students have been looking at the impact of bullying for the last two weeks during tutor time. We have been encouraging them to use their 'Power for Good' and report bullying. Food Bank: Once again, we are supporting our local foodbank and ask that any donations are brought into school on, or before, **Monday 1st December**. Student can take donations to morning tutor time. The Foodbank welcome all donations, but have specifically requested tinned food, bottles of squash or sauces, dried goods (pasta, rice, cereals, crisps, etc) and sweets/chocolates.

Maggs Day Centre House Competition: Maggs Day Centre is a Worcestershire based homeless charity and it's celebrating its 40th year anniversary this December. Pershore High School are going to support them by donating homeless care kits, which will be distributed to homeless and/or vulnerable adults in the community. We are asking each tutor group to create a care kit and have suggested the following items:

- Toothpaste - Hats
- Toothbrushes - Gloves
- Soap - High energy snack bars
- Wash cloths - A book
- Roll on deodorants - chocolate
- Socks - Sugary sweets/mints

- Wet wipes - Combs
- Hand cream - Hand sanitiser

The theme for their anniversary celebration is 'Rewrite the Story' and we have set students the challenge of writing an original poem, which will be included in the care kit. Tutor groups can create as many care kits and poems as they like, and the poems will be judged. The winning entries will receive prizes and points towards the House Cup.
